### 40+ Acres Now Under Contract! March 6th Site Visit Scheduled



Dear Members and Friends of Red Hills Community Cemetery:

Last weekend, we had an excellent turn out to come enjoy the natural beauty of the 40+ acre property now under contract for the RHCC. By our estimate, about 25% of our membership has now seen this property, off of Coe Landing Rd., which we are in the process of evaluating for purchase. We have a General Member Meeting next Sunday, March 8th at the MLC Community Center from 11 am to 1 pm followed by a short picnic (bring a camp chair and bag lunch) and meeting to discuss the creation of plans, policies, and documents necessary for creation and approval of our cemetery.

There is one more opportunity for a site visit prior to the General Membership Meeting:

**Our next tour is scheduled for this Friday, March 6th, starting at the Coe Landing property at 9:30 am.** You may meet us at the property site or meet in town to carpool with others. Please note that there are no trails yet on this property—we will be bushwhacking. Bring water, a walking stick, and whatever you use to protect against ticks and chiggers.
